Instructions for SP-207 Multiple Handgun Purchase Application

Section A of the Multiple Handgun Purchase (MHP) Application (SP-207), shall be completed in full by the transferee (buyer) and approved by the issuing agency prior to issuance of a MHP Certificate (SP-208), pursuant to § 18.2-308.2:2, Code of Virginia.

If the transferee is unable to read and/or write, the application may be completed by other persons, excluding the transferor (seller). Two persons other than the seller must sign as witnesses to the transferee's answers and signature. The transferee must certify under oath that the information provided on the form is true and correct.

Identification/Residency Documentation Requirements: Primary ID: The primary form of ID shall consist of a valid photo-ID form issued by a governmental agency of the Commonwealth that denotes the individual's name, sex, and date of birth. Where the primary form is a photo-ID issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV), at least 30-days must have elapsed since the original date of issuance.

Military Personnel: A military photo-identification card issued by the United States Department of Defense and proof that Virginia is the permanent duty station via "signed and current" military assignment orders or the purchaser's leave and earnings statement is acceptable identification and residency documentation to establish military personnel as residents of Virginia. A stamped signature is acceptable.

Non-Citizens: An Alien Registration Number must be provided in addition to the acceptable primary form of identification and residency.

<u>Section B of the Multiple Handgun Purchase (MHP) Application (SP-207)</u>, shall be completed in full by an active notary, which includes a stamp of their notary seal.

<u>Section C of the Multiple Handgun Purchase (MHP) Application (SP-207)</u>, shall be completed in full by a sworn employee of the Virginia State Police that is responsible for ensuring that Section A was completed in its entirety, signed by the customer and notarized. This shall include review of the ID and residency documentation used.

The Multiple Handgun Purchase Certificate shall be valid for seven days from the date of issuance

The Multiple Handgun Purchase Certificate shall be surrendered by the transferor (buyer) prior to consummation of such sale and shall be attached to the Virginia Firearms Transaction Record (SP-65 or SP-65B), and shall be kept on file at the transferor's place of business for inspection as provided for in 54.1 – 4201, <u>Code of Virginia</u>, for period of not less than two years.
