Members in attendance totaled 40.

The membership recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Bob McCulloch gave the invocation.

President – President King introduced Lieutenant Colonel Kirk S. Marlowe, Director of the Bureau of Administration and Support Services (BASS), as the guest speaker during the General Membership and the Dinner, giving an update on the Department's activities and answer any questions.

Vice President – Frank Williams discussed several changes to the application process several years ago and it could take up to a month before the applicant knew if they had been accepted. Currently, with the use of e-mail, the approval process takes less time and is working out very well.

He also discussed the addition of honorary members (spouses of the deceased members) and they would still be able to be a part of the organization and could attend meetings on their own and felt this was another good change.

The number of meetings were changed from three to two as a result of a survey and Frank felt that if the members show what they want, it can be resolved.

Secretary's Report – Nothing to report.

Treasurer's Report - Phyllis Allgood reported as of July 29th the balance was \$20,977.29. As of today, November 16th, the balance is \$28,680.91. There are 549 members (life and regular life members). She reminded everyone that if you are 65, you can submit a one-time fee of \$250 for dues.

Health and Welfare Report - Ron Maxey reviewed the Winter Meeting, Health and Welfare Report for November 16th and gave an update on several of the members listed on the Health and Welfare sheet that had been distributed.
