ARTICLE IV

SECTION 1: MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- (B) SWORN MEMBER: Sworn Member is defined as any Virginia State Police Officer who has successfully completed the Virginia State Police Basic Training Course and vested with the authority to enforce all criminal laws of Virginia shall be eligible to apply for membership. A Sworn Member shall be entitled to vote, hold elected office and participate in all other Alumni functions.
- (D) NONSWORN MEMBER: Nonsworn Member is defined as any retired civilian employee of the Virginia Department of State Police or any former civilian employee who left the Department with five or more years of employment shall be eligible to apply for membership. A NonSworn member shall be entitled to vote, hold elective office and participate in all other Alumni functions.

SECTION 2: ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP

- (A) All applications for membership shall be forwarded to the address shown on the application for consideration. Consideration will be given to the following factors:
 - (1) Cannot have been convicted of any criminal offense which is classified as a felony.
 - (2) Must be of such character as to uphold the

- integrity of the Department of State Police and the State Police Alumni.
- (B) The information on the application shall be verified along with any other known information and submitted to the Executive Board for a vote.
- (C) The Executive Board who, through a majority vote of those members present at a regular Executive Board Meeting, called Executive Board Meeting or Electronic Polling of Board Members by telephone, email, text message or other similar methods, shall accept or reject the application.
- (D) An appeal of the Executive Board's decision shall be handled as follows.
 - (1) The appellant shall make known their desire to appeal the decision in writing within 20 days of receipt of notice.
 - (2) Their appeal shall be presented to the members, at large, at the next general conference.
 - (3) The Executive Board and the appellant will be given an opportunity to present their cases before the general membership.
 - (4) The general membership shall vote in secret to uphold or reverse the Executive Board decision. This decision shall be final and no further appeal and/or new application will be heard.

Retiree Death Information/Contacts

If Your Loved One Dies While Retired

Securian Financial, insurer for the

Virginia Retirement System Group Life

Insurance Program, can initiate all VRS benefit claims and will provide information to VRS for processing any benefits due. Examples include:

- Life insurance.
- Payment of any remaining contributions in the retiree's defined benefit account.
- Any funds in a VRS Defined Contribution Plan, if the employee participated. For more information, call Securian Financial at 800-441-2258.

Virginia Retirement System:

Call 888-827-3847 or visit varetire.org.

Securian Financial: Call 800-441-2258.

VRS Defined Contribution Plans:

Call 877-327-5261 and ask to speak with a Participant Services Representative, or visit varetire.org/dcp.

Social Security Survivor Benefits:

Call the Social Security Administration at 800-772-1213, contact your local Social Security Administration office or visit socialsecurity.gov.

Taxation of Benefits: Consult a tax advisor, call the IRS at 800-829-1040 or visit irs.gov.

Workers' Compensation Survivor Benefits:

Contact the member's human resource office.

Order of Precedence:

If there is no valid beneficiary designation on file or the beneficiary is deceased, VRS is required by law to pay benefits according to the order of precedence:

- First, to the spouse of the member.
- Second, if no surviving spouse, to the children of the member and descendants of deceased children, per stirpes.
- Third, if none of the above, to the parents of the member.
- Fourth, if none of the above, to the duly appointed executor or administrator of the estate of the member.
- Fifth, if none of the above, to other next of kin of the member entitled under the laws of the domicile of the member at the time of death.

If Your Loved One Is Terminally Ill:

The **accelerated death benefit** is paid while a member or retiree is still living. Eligible members or retirees diagnosed with a terminal condition with fewer than 12 months to live can withdraw some or all of their life insurance proceeds to use for any purpose. A beneficiary or survivor will receive any remaining amount upon the member's or retiree's death. For more information, call:Securian Financial, 800-441-2258.

Taxation of Benefits:

Any distributions a beneficiary or survivor receives will be subject to federal and state income taxes. See the IRS 402(f) Special Tax Notice available at varetire.org/forms.
