General Membership Meeting, November 11, 2023, Virginia Beach

President Ronald M. Kranchick called the meeting to order at 3:05 p.m.

The General Membership recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America, and invocation was given by John T. O'Neil.

Members in attendance totaled 27.

The were no Trustees present.

President – President Kranchick welcomed everyone. He started the meeting by explaining how Article IV (new language for the Appeal Process) had been approved by the General Membership at the April 22, 2023 meeting that would allow a rejected applicant the right to appeal that vote. Cheryl Petska attended today's meeting to appeal the rejection of her membership and would be allowed to present her side.

Ronald Kranchick said today after listening to both sides, the General Membership would vote to accept or reject her. Dale Gouldman asked who would be sitting on the panel voting, if the Board was included in the General Membership voting and Ronald Kranchick responded yes, the Board is part of the General Membership. Ronald Kranchick then called John T. O'Neil representing the Board's side and then Cheryl Petska would be given a chance to speak.

John O'Neil spoke first on behalf of the Board. He said the Board determines whether an applicant is accepted or rejected based on the by-laws. The Alumni is a social group and a non-profit organization, but at the same time the integrity of the Alumni and the Department of State Police has to be maintained. He said it would be up to the General Membership after hearing both sides to vote to approve or reject her application.

Ms. Petska was called upon and she asked that her husband, Mark Petska, speak first. Mr. Petska made his presentation and felt there was not anyone in the room that would not support their wife as he was doing. He said hopefully the membership would hear what he said and understand the facts.

Dale Gouldman then spoke in favor of Ms. Petska and also regarding the calling and discussing of applicants. Andy Engemann said it is not unusual for Board members to talk to each other and are operating in good faith.

Cheryl Petska presented her side and after reading her statement, said she would answer any questions.

Ronald Kranchick said there would be a silent vote by marking either yes or no on a 3 X 5 note card and asked Charlie Compton and Colonel M. Wayne Huggins (Retired) to count the votes. The final vote was to accept Cheryl Petska as a member.

Treasurer's Report - Ronald Kranchick read the information from Phyllis Allgood, who is still in rehab, stating that the checking account balance as of October 30, 2023 was \$31,023.97. At this time, John O'Neil read a letter from Phyllis resigning her position as Treasurer and Richard Allgood resigning his position of Sergeant at Arms.
